

Welcome!

Whether you have come to St Saviour's or to St Paul's, whether you are here as a visitor or someone who has worshipped here for a while, welcome! It is good to have you with us today. The advantage of being a Parish of two churches means we can offer a variety of worship styles - and starting times – to suit most

people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him.

Here is our Sunday service information:

St Paul's Church

Rev Ben Goodyear

8am every week there is a traditional, said Holy Communion (1662 Book of Common Prayer).

11:15am morning service. The usual pattern is this: on the first and third Sunday of the month we celebrate Holy Communion (HC) using services from Common Worship, with groups for children up to 14 years. On second Sundays we usually have Morning Worship (MW), also with children's groups. The fourth Sunday's service (WT) is a much shorter service and is aimed at people of all ages. You are welcome to go with young children to the crèche at any point.

5pm The Five – an informal and interactive evening service every week. We begin by chatting together over pizza and drinks as we arrive. Then, after some singing, the sermon usually involves breaking out into smaller groups to discuss questions together. There is then some more singing and a chance to receive prayer.

St Saviour's Church

9:30am We follow the same service pattern as the 11.15am service. More than that, the same people preach the same sermon! The main difference is that whereas St Paul's has a choir and organ, St Saviour's has a more informal music group and a supervised crèche during term time as well as children's groups for young people up to 14 years. St Saviour's also works in close co-operation with the Parish's school next door.

3pm Messy Church service on the last Sunday of every month. Join us for crafts, games, and a light supper.
