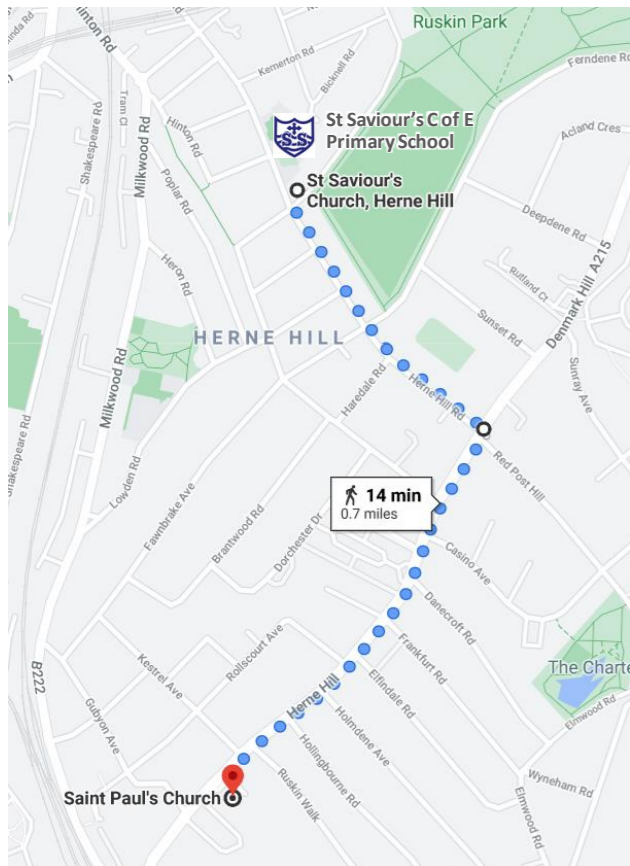

Welcome to St Saviour's or to St Paul's! We are a Parish of two churches, which means we can offer a variety of worship styles – and starting times – to suit most people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him. Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary.

Our **9.30am** and **11.15am** Sunday services have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

The Five is an informal evening service every week at **5pm** at St Paul's, with food and drink, singing, a sermon with time to talk through things together and a chance to receive prayer. Once a month we do a praise and prayer evening, and we also have a monthly social.

Messy Church Come join us at St Saviour's Church on *Sunday 27th November* at **3pm** for sensory arts and crafts, games, singing, Bible stories and refreshments for all families. This ministry is suitable for Primary School aged children.

Loss and Damage - Rise up and Pay Up
COP 27 is taking place in Egypt from 6th -18th November. At COP 26, rich nations were encouraged to set up a fund to compensate poorer nations for the loss and damage incurred due to the climate emergency. Little progress has been made since COP 26, so in the run-up to COP 27 Christian Aid is calling on governments across the world to set up a new international fund to pay for loss and damage.
