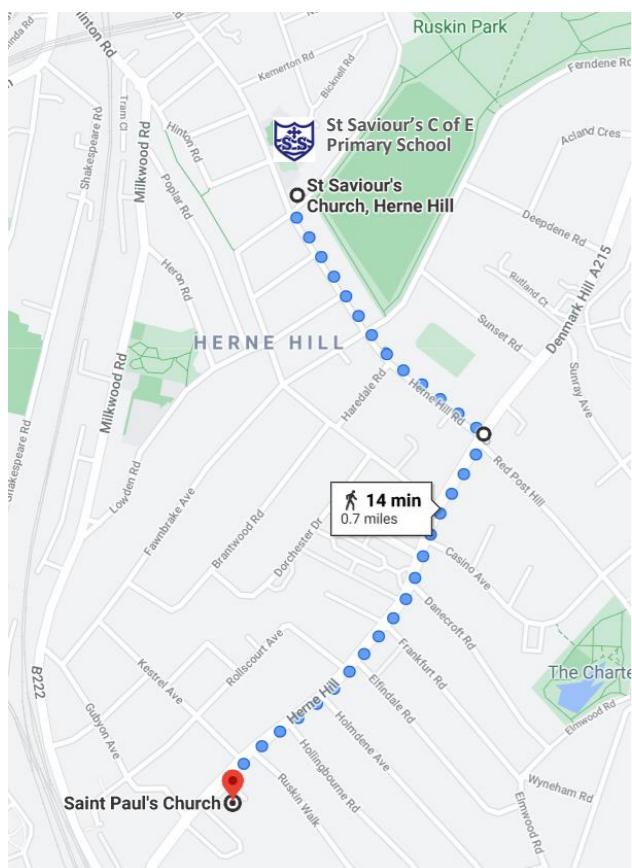

Welcome to St Saviour's or to St Paul's! We are a Parish of two churches, which means we can offer a variety of worship styles - and starting times - to suit most people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him. Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary.

Our **9.30am** and **11.15am** Sunday services have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

The Five is an informal evening service every week at **5pm** at St Paul's. On arrival, there's food and drink available. Then, after some singing, the sermon begins and usually involves a time to talk through things together. There is then some more worship and a chance to receive prayer. Once a month we do a praise and prayer evening, and we also have a monthly social.

Messy Church Come join us at St Saviour's Church on *Sunday 30th October* at **3pm** for sensory arts and crafts, games, singing, Bible stories and refreshments for all families. This month we are having a Glo party! This ministry is suitable for Primary School aged children.
