

Welcome to St Saviour's or to St Paul's! We are a Parish of two churches, which means we can offer a variety of worship styles and starting times - to suit most people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him. Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary. **Rev Ben Goodyear**

Our 9.30am and 11.15am Sunday services have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

The Five is an informal evening service every week at 5pm at St Paul's, with food and drink, singing, a sermon with time to talk through things together and a chance to receive prayer. Advent and Christmas are often busy times when we are rushing about. I invite you to read 'The Ruthless Elimination of Hurry' by John Mark Comer over Advent or in the lull after Christmas to help you stay emotionally healthy and spiritually alive. The book is a deep reflection on Jesus' words from Matthew 11:28-30: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for vour souls. For my voke is easy and my burden is light." John Mark suggests 4 practices of Jesus to imitate: Silence & Solitude, Sabbath, Simplicity, and Slowing.
