During the Nazi occupation, they chose to act out their faith through peaceful resistance to the Nazis by active participation in the Dutch underground. They were hiding, feeding and transporting Jews and underground members hunted by the Gestapo. It is estimated they were able to save the lives of 800 Jews. This book tells her story including when she ended up in a concentration camp and how God was present even in such a difficult place.
