

Our regular Sunday services start with our **8am** service at St Paul's (<u>apart from during all of August</u>), a traditional, said Holy Communion (1662 Book of Common Prayer). The **9.30am** service (at St Saviour's) and **11.15am** service (at St Paul's) have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 1st, 3rd and 4th Sundays in July, and we also have creche facilities at both churches. <u>Services in August are all-age</u>.

Revd Ben's book of the month: How to Hear God by Pete Greig

I read this book on Sabbatical and enjoyed the mix of theology, story and practical help. Greig says that hearing God should be a normal Christian experience, not the sole province of wild-eyed mystics. His key biblical text is the road to Emmaus. In this short narrative, he says, we see God communicate in at least five ways: conversational (as they walked), exegetical (unpacking scripture), sacramental (breaking bread), prophetic (their eyes were opened), and inward (their hearts were burning).
