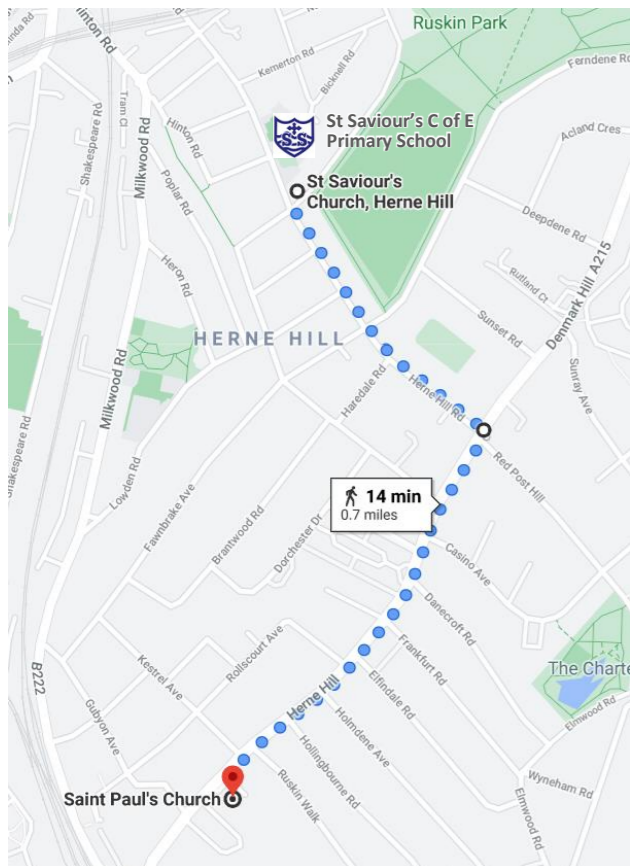

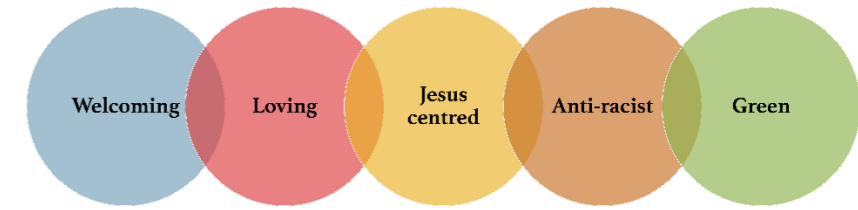

Welcome to St Saviour's or to St Paul's! We are a Parish of two churches, which means we can offer a variety of worship styles – and starting times – to suit most people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him. Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary.

Our regular Sunday services start with our **8am** service at St Paul's, a traditional, said Holy Communion (1662 Book of Common Prayer). The **9.30am** service (at St Saviour's) and **11.15am** service (at St Paul's) have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

The Five is an informal evening service every week at **5pm** at St Paul's, with food and drink, singing, a Bible-based talk with time for reflection and discussion and a chance to receive prayer.

Messy Church Come join us at St Saviour's Church on **Sunday 19th May at 3pm** for sensory arts & crafts, games, singing, Bible stories and refreshments for all families. This ministry is suitable for Primary School aged children.

WHOOSH

Whoosh is our annual parish long distance cycle ride. This year, 30 people from our parish community past and present, will be heading back to where Whoosh began 20 years ago – the Welsh hills! We will be cycling up the west coast of Wales from Tenby to Llandudno from *Friday 3rd May to Monday 6th May*, raising money for two charities. Our local charity is CHIPS (Christian International Peace Service). They aim to bring about peace and reconciliation in areas of conflict or tension. We will focus on their work with young people in Brixton to address serious youth violence. Our youth leader Cas Moyo is closely involved in this. Our international charity is Gaza Sunbirds at Amos Trust. Amos are a small international justice charity. They support the Gaza Sunbirds, an incredible group of cycling para-athletes who deliver food packs, tents and medical supplies in the Gaza strip.
