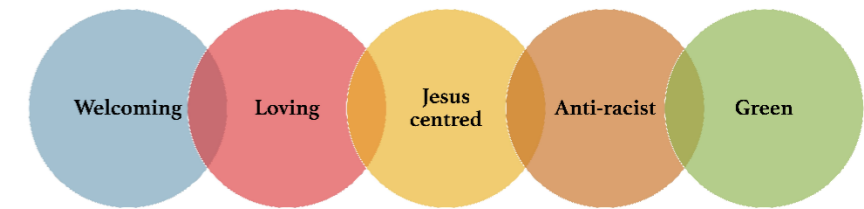

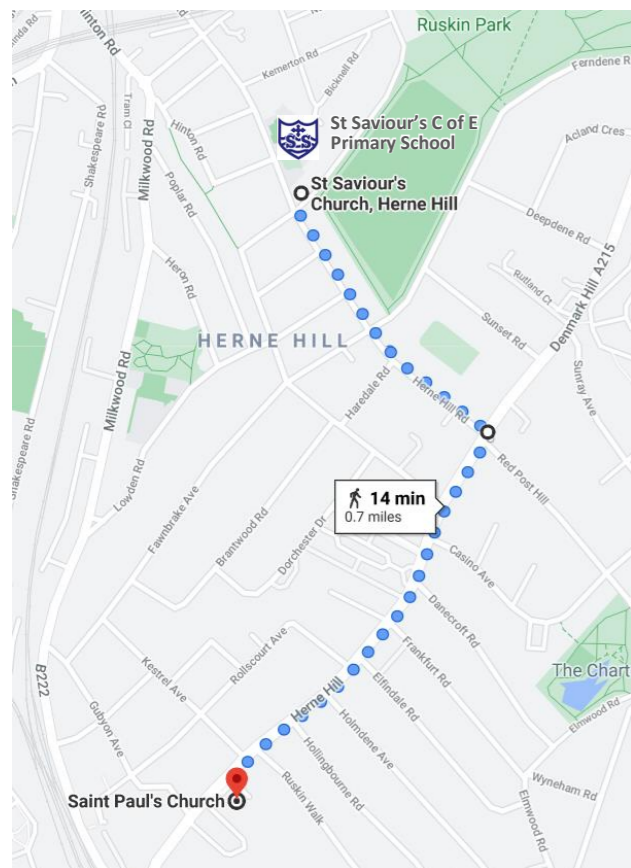
Our regular Sunday services start with our **8am** service at St Paul's, a traditional, said Holy Communion (1662 Book of Common Prayer). The **9.30am** service (at St Saviour's) and **11.15am** service (at St Paul's) have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

Revd Ben's book of the month:

Getting Your Kids Through Church Without Them Ending Up Hating God by Rob Parsons

The problem Parsons sets out to deal with is the number of young people who leave church as soon as they can. He believes that in this they are not turning their back on God but rather what we have presented to them as church. He also challenges each of us to consider whether there is anything we can change in our homes, churches and hearts, which will make it less likely that a generation will be lost from the church. 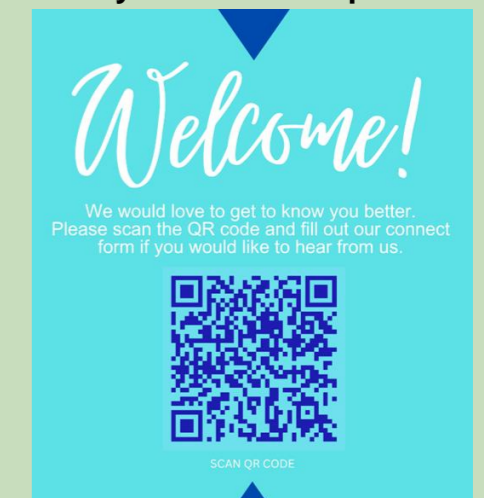
