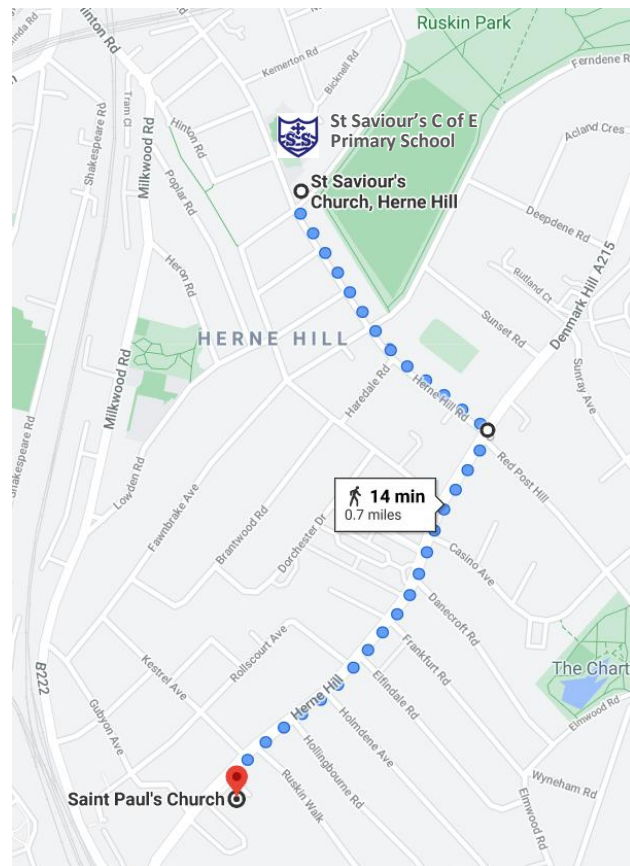

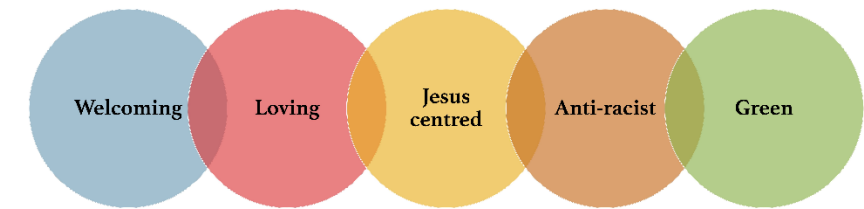

All welcome, no exceptions, come as you are.

Welcome to St Saviour's or to St Paul's! We are a Parish of two churches, which means we can offer a variety of worship styles – and starting times – to suit most people. It also makes us like any normal family, a mixture of all sorts. What holds us together is a shared faith in God, and our commitment to live for him. Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary.

Our regular Sunday services start with our **8am** service at St Paul's (apart from during all of August), a traditional, said Holy Communion (1662 Book of Common Prayer). The **9.30am** service (at St Saviour's) and **11.15am** service (at St Paul's) have groups for children and young people of all ages on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Sundays in term time, and we also have creche facilities at both churches.

The Five is an informal evening service (except during August), **5pm** weekly at St Paul's. The Five is an inclusive and informal evening service with food, worship, great discussion, a chance to ask questions and receive prayer.

Messy Church Come join us at St Saviour's Church on **Sunday 6th July at 3pm** for sensory arts & crafts, games, singing, Bible stories and refreshments for all families. This ministry is suitable for Primary School aged children. Messy Church takes a break in August.
