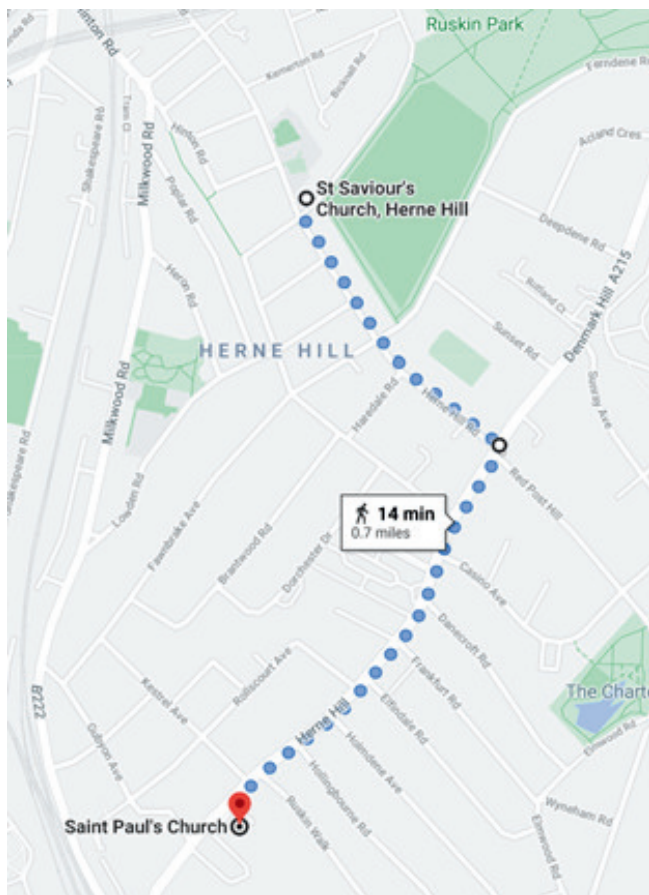

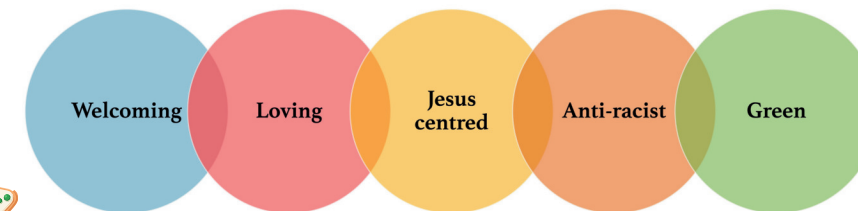

Welcome to the Parish of Herne Hill!

We are two churches, St Paul's & St Saviour's, with multiple congregations. Together we aim, **in God's strength, to bring Jesus to the centre of our lives and the heart of our community.**

Both churches work in close co-operation with the Parish's school, St Saviour's Primary.

Our Sunday services are:

- **8am** BCP service at St Paul's - a traditional, said Holy Communion
- **9.30am** service at St Saviour's - with worship band, and groups for children on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Sundays in term time, as well as crèche facilities
- **11.15am** service at St Paul's - with choir and organ, and groups for children on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Sundays in term time, as well as crèche facilities
- **The Five** service, **5pm** at St Paul's - informal evening service with discussion (except 14th/21st/28th December).
- **Messy Church** 2nd Sunday of each month, **3pm** at St Saviour's Church for sensory arts & crafts, games, singing, Bible stories and refreshments for all families. This ministry is suitable for Primary School aged children.

Advent Devotional: The Fruit of the Spirit: Preparing Our Hearts for Christ's Coming

This Advent, we will journey together through the fruits of the Spirit, as found in Galatians 5:22-23: love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Each week, we will explore different clusters of these fruits, and hear from members of our church family. They will share honestly about which fruits flow naturally in their lives and which ones feel like a struggle. These personal reflections remind us that spiritual growth is not about achieving perfection. It is about bringing our whole selves before God, including our strengths and weaknesses, and trusting the Holy Spirit to do His transforming work.
