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ROLE SUMMARY

What is the role’s main purpose: *What will you be doing? The main purpose of the role is to help provide a safe space for Youth to enjoy activities and make friends. You will be provided with a great opportunity to build relationships with the local youth Community. The Youth will play board games and other activities such as table tennis and Nintendo Switch. On most weeks everyone will come together to play a fun game that will be led by the YFC Leader There will also be opportunities to run a game yourself if you wish to do so. We also bring everyone together as a group to listen and interact with a biblically based short talk on a topic provided by the Leader.*

When and where will you be doing it? *Youth Faith Collective takes place at St Paul’s Church on Herne Hill each Thursday during the school term from 6:30 to 8pm Those that are serving will arrive by 6pm to help set up. games and art resources or start preparing Pizzas and squash ready for when the Youth arrive.*

Raising Awareness of Domestic abuse can be completed within the first year of joining children and Youth Ministry. There is also the option to do Children and Youth Ministry training with the Diocese.
	Support you will be given. The leader will provide an informal induction to include familiarising yourself with the Church building.
Safeguarding	Your role involves contact with children and young people.
	You will be required to attend relevant safeguarding training.
	You will be expected to work within the policy and procedures of the relevant safeguarding policy, by sharing any concerns with the Parish Safeguarding Officer.
Health and Safety	Your supervisor will help you familiarise yourself with the Risk Assessment for the activity and record/report to them any near misses or concerns. One pager on health and Safety can be found on the Parish Website.
